An anti-nausea medication often added when starting or increasing a GLP-1 like semaglutide or tirzepatide.

AVAILABLE AS

- Oral tablets: 4 mg (20 tabs)
- Optional, on request or when your provider recommends it

MAY HELP WITH

- ✓ Nausea during GLP-1 dose increases
- ✓ Staying on track with your program

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

- Constipation
- Headache
- Dizziness or tiredness

NOT FOR YOU IF

- Long QT or certain heart-rhythm conditions
- Taking apomorphine
- Allergy to similar anti-nausea medicines

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
